This document will outline the steps to set up the Exostar EAG Enterprise Application. Please ensure you have purchased one of the following licenses:

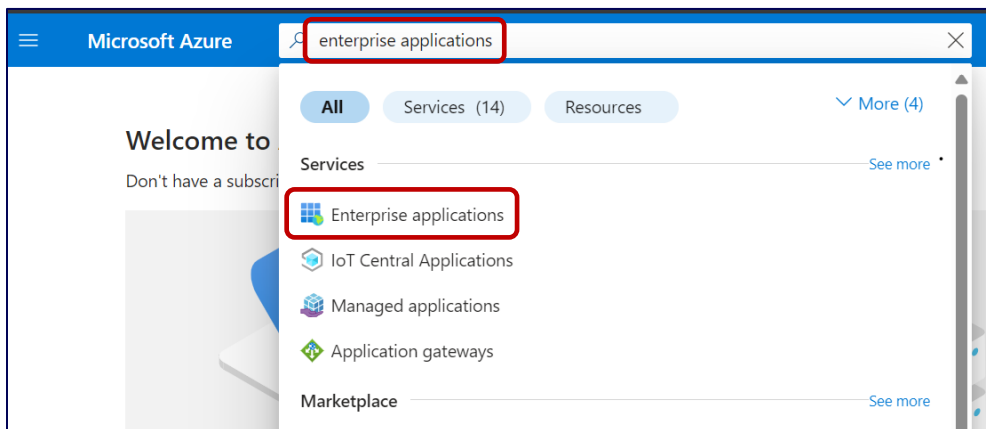

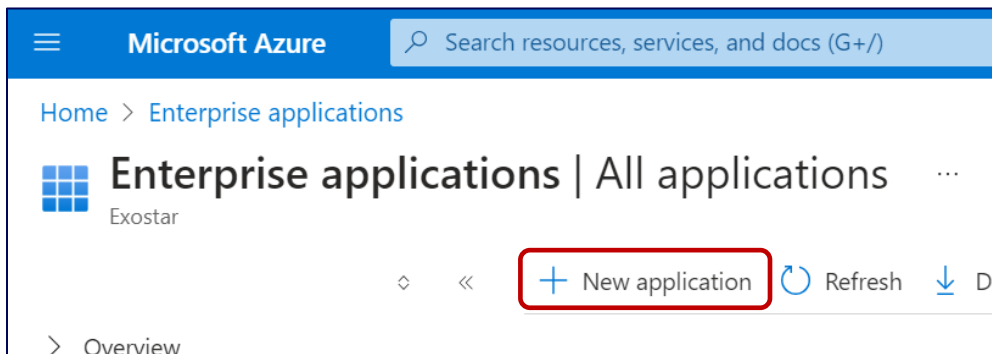
Setup Enterprise Application

To set up the EAG Enterprise Application, follow the steps below:

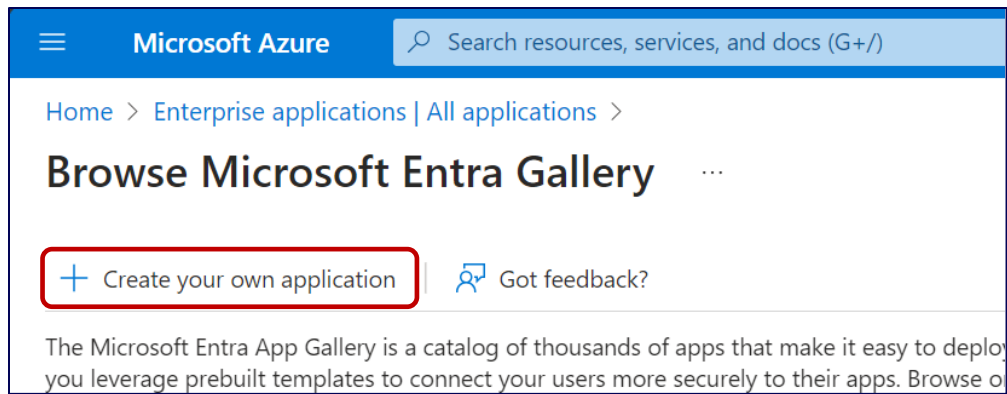
1. Navigate to <https://portal.azure.com>. Type **Enterprise Applications** in the top search field. Select Enterprise applications under Services.



2. Select : **+ New application** at the top right of the screen.



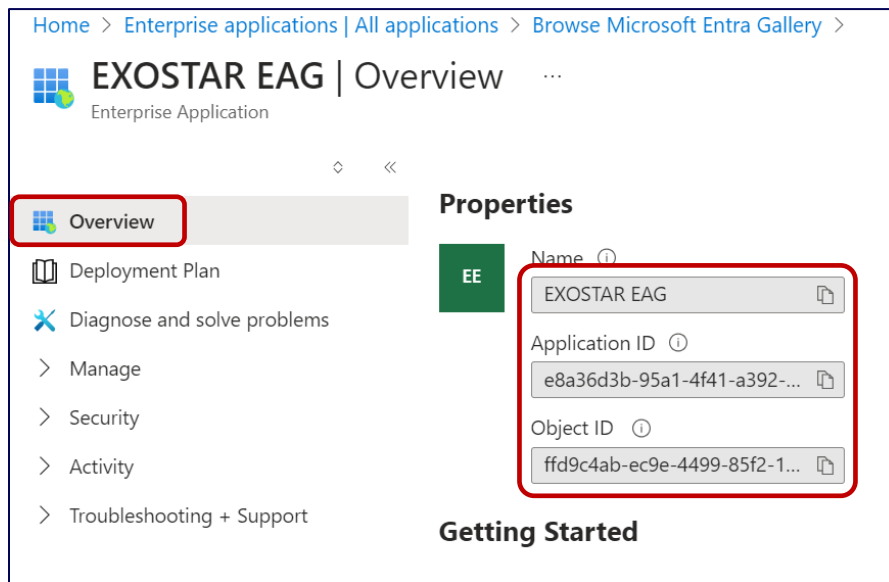
3. Select **+ Create your own application**.



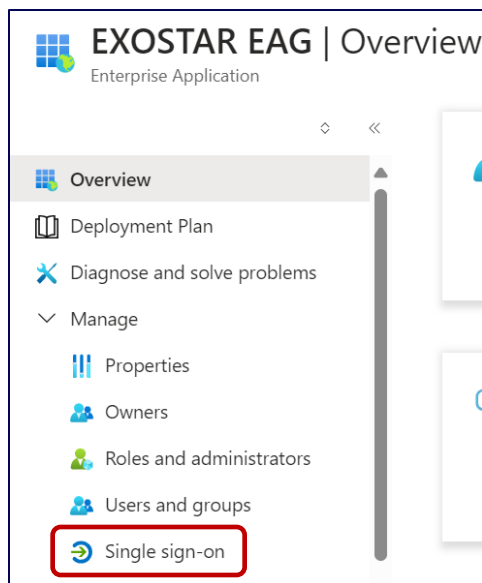
4. Input the name of your app, (i.e. Exostar EAG) and select the option **Integrate any other application you don't find in the gallery (Non-gallery)**. Then select **Create**.

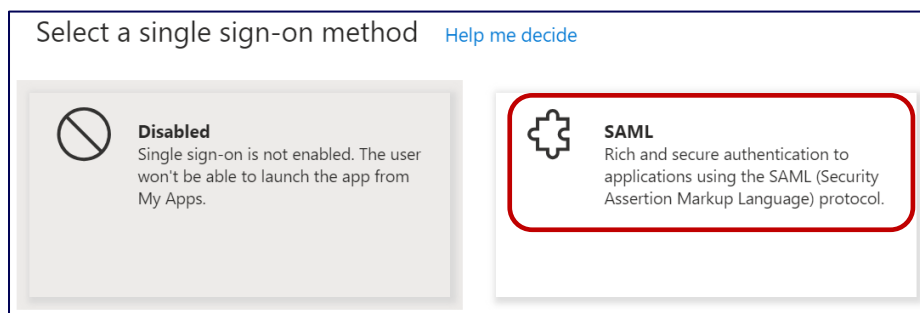
5. After application is created you will see the **Overview** screen for the application with Application name, Application ID and Object ID.



6. On the left-side menu, under **Manage**, select **Single sign-on**.



7. Next select your single sign-on method, choose **SAML**.



8. Complete the **Set up Single Sign-on SAML** page with the configurations demonstrated below:

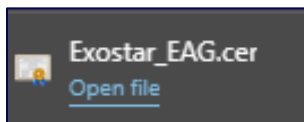

9. The following claims must be entered manually. Quotes will automatically be added:
 - assurancelevel – type level_3
 - authenticator1 – companyname
 - credentialsource1 – companyname
 - credentialtype1 – password
 - specificationid – urn:com:exostartest:assertion-profiles:eag:1.1
10. Confirm all settings are correct. Next Download the Certificate (Base64) and send it to Exostar PM via zip or by converting it to a .txt file before emailing. Make sure you take note of where you are downloading the **.cer** file.



11. Finally select **Users and groups**, then select **+ Add user/group**. Next choose the group which has the users that will require access to the application.

NOTE: You may have to create the group and add the members if it does not exist (see screenshots below).
